The wetting agents and electrolytes in the ProBalance Technology help tear film stability and keep lenses feeling fresh through long workdays or hours of looking at device screens.

The ease of handling has real clinical implications. Historically, Dr. Snipes sometimes hesitated to recommend a daily disposable for first-time contact lens wearers because of concerns about handling. With INFUSE, that barrier is low. The lens is an excellent match for new-wearer candidates who are ready to try contact lenses but might struggle with application or removal. These lenses are easy to handle and easy to insert.

Within the INFUSE family, the multifocal has particular prominence and has become one of the most popular multifocal daily options in his practice. Because it shares the same 3-Zone Progressive™ Design as the Bausch + Lomb ULTRA® lens he's used for years, the multifocal represents a straightforward progression for patients and clinicians alike. He can transition a patient from a spherical INFUSE to

the multifocal without changing fit philosophy. Plus, his long experience with the ULTRA design gives him the assurance that the multifocal will perform predictably and provide his patients with excellent vision at all distances. That continuity—the ability to move from spherical to multifocal within the same design family—simplifies chair time and reduces the need for repeated adjustments.

Smart business

In addition, the INFUSE family fits into broader business decisions. Among the premium daily offerings in his office, Bausch + Lomb strengthens the financial considerations with its high-value rebate. This makes INFUSE "a win for both of us," Dr. Snipes says. Patients appreciate the comfort, clarity of vision and ease of use, and Dr. Snipes can offer and transition more of his patients into an advanced technology one-day lens.

Dr. Snipes encourages optometrists to offer patients the opportunity to try a different lens that might help provide them with excellent acuity and all-day comfort. Even if patients have dropped out of contact lenses in the past, Dr. Snipes can mention the advances in materials and design that might help patients achieve an excellent contact lens experience now. Non-wearers and wearers of other contact lenses may not know what benefits they might gain from making a switch, so Dr. Snipes wants to make it easy to let them try these lenses and experience the advantages for themselves.
